GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE PRINCIPALS OF UNDERGRADUATE COLLEGES ON THE CURRICULUM AS SUGGESTED BY THE SEP COMMISSION

- 1. All the syllabi are prepared by the respective Boards of Studies as per the structure finalized by the University in consultation with SEP Commission.
- 2. Generally, one credit is equivalent to one hour of instruction in theory and 2 hours of tutorial / practical / field work / project work / internship. In the case of languages, 3 credits are equivalent to 4 hours of instruction.

In BSc and BA with practical programs, 5 credit per course is divided into (3+2) credits. 3 credit for theory has 4 hours of teaching workload and 2 credit for practical has 4 hours of workload.

In BA programs, 6 hours of teaching is allotted for 5 credit of each paper.

The compulsory courses in 1st and 2nd semester have 2 credits each and their workload is 3hours/week. First semester of all the UG programs will have Constitutional Values as compulsory course and in the second semester, Environmental studies will be the compulsory course.

The practical / practicum batches should have one teacher up to 15 students. The government order in this regard is applicable wherever necessary.

- 3. The Elective courses will be related to the core subjects. Students will select the Electives that are related to the core subjects that they study.
- 4. One each of the three compulsory courses (practical knowledge/ skill) will be related to one each of the three core courses. The practical knowledge / skill based course will be prescribed to students as follows:
 - The practical knowledge / skill based course related to the first of the three major courses will be prescribed in the fourth semester.
 - The practical knowledge / skill based course related to the second of the three major courses will be prescribed in the fifth semester.
 - The practical knowledge / skill based course related to the third of the three major courses will be prescribed in the sixth semester.
- 5. English which is one of the two language courses will be mandatory for all students. The second language course will be Kannada or any other Indian language.

Professional courses like BHM and BSc (Hospitality Science) may offer French instead of an Indian language in the third and fourth semesters. This aspect will be confirmed once the final report by SEP commission is submitted and accepted by the Govt, of Karnataka.
