Proceedings of the meeting of the OBC Cell Committee held on Saturday, the 31st August, 2024 at 11.00 a.m. in the chamber of the OBC Cell Coordinator (Room No.S-34, 2nd Floor, Science Faculty Building), Mangalore University, Mangalgangothri.

Chairman welcomed honorable members of the OBC Cell Committee to the meeting.

Following agenda were discussed.

Agenda 1: To prepare budget estimate for the welfare measures of the OBC students

The coordinator presented the letter received from the university asking for the budget estimate to implement the welfare measures suggested by the committee in its previous meeting. He also presented the statistics of both I and II year OBC students of previous academic year collected from the PG departments/Programmes. The committee noted that there were 1128 OBC students out of 2116 students on the campus (~52%). Out of 1128 OBC students, 943 students had their annual family income below 1 lakh rupees. The committee prepared a budget estimate by taking into account of 900 OBC to implement the welfare measures to OBC students as detailed below:

2.	Financial Assistance to Project Work/Report @ Rs. 1,000/- per student	Rs. 1,000/- x 900 students	Rs. 9,00,000/-
3.	Field-work/Industrial Visit @ Rs. 2,000/- per student	Rs. 2,000/- x 900 students	Rs. 18,00,000/-
4.	Ph.D. Fellowship @ Rs. 10,000/- per research scholar	Rs. 10,000/- x 26 students (1 each from 26 departments)	Rs. 2,60,000/-
Total Budget			Rs. 47,60,000/-

It was resolved to send this budget estimate to the University for the Implementation.

Any other relevant matter

The committee resolved to create awareness about Govt. scholarship schemes available for the OBC students of during library orientation programme and requesting the chairperson/coordinator of the concerned department/programme to educate the OBC students about these facilities and to encourage them to apply for such scholarships.


