The University Campus at Mangalagangothri and the PG Centre at Chikka Alvara, Kodagu District together have 29 academic departments spread over four faculties: Arts, Commerce, Education and Science & Technology. There are 40 Master Programmes, 11 Doctoral Programmes and PG Diplomas on offer. A total of 207 colleges in Dakshina Kannada, Udupi and Kodagu Districts are affiliated to the University.</p> <p>The research facilities on the campus include University Science Instrumentation Centre, Microscopy Centre, Centre for Advanced Research in Environmental Radioactivity (CARE), Centre for Application of Biotechnology and Radiation Technology (CART), University of University Research and Scientific Facilities (URSF), and NMR Instrumentation Centre. The University has over 10 ongoing research projects and the total grants sanctioned for these projects amount to over 25 crores. The University has achieved ICOPES b-index of 1.1 as on 2022.</p> <p>The University is associated with the Karnataka Events Index Journal (2019-22), is placed 162nd in the country among Indian Universities in the US NewsWorld University Rankings, 2022, and placed in Rank-band, 101-150 in NIRF Rankings, 2022. The University has established about 14 Endowment Chairs and Study Centres to achieve development in various areas. It strengthens links with society.</p> <p>Over the past 42 years, Mangalore University has grown and earned a respectable position among HEIs in the country and is forging ahead with the philosophy 'continuity with change'.</p> <p>About the IQAC</p> <p>In pursuance of the National Action plan of NAAC for performance evaluation, assessment, accreditation and quality upgradation of institutions of higher education, the IQAC was established in the year 2012. As per the spirit of NAAC guidelines, the IQAC has been striving for internalization and institutionalization of quality enhancement. It is working as a facilitative voluntary system of the University. Over the last six years IQAC has contributed significantly in areas like preparation and submission of AQARs, Accreditation, India National/International Rankings, Online collection of Stakeholders Feedback, Internal promotion such as CAS, Participation under Gender Advancement for Transforming Institutions (GATI), 402, Knowledge/Quality Journal Review, Survey, Assessment Programs, Quality/Skill enhancement workshops, Professional/Capacity Development Programs, etc.</p> <p>About the Workshop NAAC Being and becoming an accredited institution through nationally/internationally recognized accreditation and ranking bodies is the order of the day. Stakeholders such as students and prospective faculty and also Govt and non Govt funding agencies look to these to guide their decisions on application and award of grants for research and other infrastructural developments. This can be achieved only through a conscientious process involving policy, implementation, assessment, evaluation of a quality culture involving all stakeholders like administration, faculty, researchers, students, and non-teaching support staff.</p> <p>NIRF The National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) outlines a methodology to rank institutions across the country.
