- 1. Regarding the letter submitted to the University on 31.03.2022 concerning deduction of exchange money from the official account of the Centre for Women's Studies by the Forex Department of State Bank of India Mangalore, and for which the Director had to spent her personal money on conducting activities of the Centre, the University decided that this money would be reimbursed to the official account of the Centre for Women's Studies.
