- B. The candidates in the waiting list will take a chance according to the order of merit only if the candidates in the Provisional Selection List do not take admission by 4th October 2023. The candidates who do not get selected under general category can opt for admission under Partially Self-Financing Category.
- C. All candidates in the Waiting List should report with 1 passport size photograph, original documents and required fee (can be paid through bank or online) on 5th October 2023 at 9.45 a.m. without fail.
