Interactive Workshop on NAAC Reforms held on 09-09-2024 at 2:30 PM in the Dr. U. R. Rao Hall, Science Block, Mangalagangothri.

Report

The Interactive Workshop commenced with an update by the Director of IQAC, Prof. Monika Sadananda on the previous NAAC outcome highlighting metrics for improvement. She also briefed about the new NAAC Reforms and salient features of the same. The Deputy Director of IQAC Prof. Vinay Rajath D. explained about the objectives, features, criteria and summary of the “Dr. Radhakrishnan Report” that led to the NAAC Reforms. The Director of IQAC Prof. Monika Sadananda explained the Attributes 1, 2, 3, 4, 7 while the Deputy Director of IQAC Prof. Vishalakshi B. explained the Attributes 5, 6, 8, 9, 10 of Binary Accreditation Framework as per the classification of Inputs, Process and Outcomes.

After the presentation the floor was open for discussion and some of the faculties raised some questions and suggestions about Binary Accreditation Process has mentioned below: It was suggested that individual faculty can submit their papers, publications and other details directly to IQAC through online mode. It was also suggested that the University should have a separate budget for NAAC activities. Concerns were expressed regarding University adoption of NEP-2020 and revised NEP (State Education Policy). It was also suggested to form sub-committees to prepare template criteria wise with data and documentation.

The Finance Officer explained regarding the financial metrics. The Registrar exhorted departments to improve publication, placements of students, to create student club etc. for overall improvement of NAAC outcomes. Hon’ble Vice Chancellor explained various attributes of the NAAC Binary Accreditation Process of relevance to Mangalore University. The meeting ended with an expression of thanks to all the participants for their active participation and valuable inputs. Dr. Preethi Keerthi D’Souza compered the programme.
